We were well received and I was able to lay a solid foundation in the cross of Jesus while dealing with some key issues for the nation. Many of the delegates also married the Lord and a new firehouse has been birthed!

From there we travelled to Namibia for a Businessmen's Intercession Seminar. I taught on the difference between Christians in business and Kingdom businesspeople. We covered many topics including seats of authority, apostolic alignment for businesses as well as practical financial issues. God sealed our time together anointing us to birth the kingdom seeds that had been sown. Watch for a kingdom economic model coming out of Namibia!

Lance also presented another AG Business Seminar in Johannesburg. He taught on taking your seat of authority over your business and learning to administrate from that place. We ended the seminar by praying and setting each person in their seat of authority.

We were invited to minister to a group of pastors and leaders in Pinetown, KZN for the African Christian Democratic Party. I released a word on the 'Ecclesia' and the need for us to be that 'Ecclesia' if we are going to reform society. It was extremely well-received and we are looking forward to working with the ACDP to release Kingdom Government in our nation.

Right now I am at the FireHouse in George to meet with and encourage the intercessors here. I travel to Cape Town and Saldanha Bay later this week for a quick visit to those FireHouses. I am so encouraged by all that God is doing in these regional areas!

Remember that we start our corporate fast on Thursday, 18 March for 10 days. Each day we will pray into one of the 10 commandments - repenting for where we have broken it and then affirming each commandment as one of our marriage vows. We will end the fast with a baptismal service at the Ariel Gate House on Sunday, 28 March.

I believe that this fast is extremely significant as we cannot go to Mount Zion if we have not been at Mount Sinai and affirmed our marriage covenant. We need to divorce every other god that says it owns us. We must make a public declaration that we will not give our seed to another God. In the Old Testament, the Jews were circumcised as a sign that they would not give their seed to another God. Every male child was circumcised at 8 days (before any seed was ever split) as a sign of their marriage covenant with God. Under the New Covenant, baptism is our circumcision.

In Him you were also circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, by putting off the body of the sins of the flesh, by the circumcision of Christ Colossians 2:11 If you have never been baptised as an adult - I recommend that you do as soon as possible!

We are going to Mount Zion in April 2010. I hope that you have all registered and have been preparing yourselves for this convention. Our speakers have all confirmed their attendance and we are looking forward to an intense time of revelation, intercession and kingdom legislation!

WILL BUILD MY ECCLESIA

Jesus came to earth and died on the cross to birth a church that would establish His Kingdom Rule in every sphere of society in the earth. The beginning sign of His ministry was signs and wonders, but His ultimate sacrifice on the cross was not to meet our needs or to get us to heaven - His sacrifice was made for the complete reformation of society! Anything less than that would be a mismanagement of that sacrifice.

If we look at the church today, we have not achieved this. And if we continue to do what we have always done, we will never achieve it. It is time to change! If we are going to reform the seven mountains of society - Religion, Education, Family, Finance, Government, Arts and Culture and Media - we need to be the Church or Ecclesia that Jesus said He would build in Matthew 16:18.

In this scripture, Jesus deliberately used the word 'ecclesia', knowing that it was a Roman military term for a group of people who were 'called out' and elected to govern. Ecclesia was a Roman term and not a Jewish one. Jesus was announcing that what He would build to establish His Kingdom would be fundamentally different from the Synagogue system that the Jews were familiar with at that time.

The apostles of the day understood that Jesus was making a revolutionary statement. The body He would build would be governmental



in nature and lead by a military group of leaders or apostles. We have watered this scripture down to mean the local church, but Jesus always intended to build an ecclesia that would reform and govern society.

The ecclesia was not a pastoral model, but an apostolic one. Jesus spent three and a half years training twelve apostles. He poured His life and vision into them. On the day of Pentecost, there was only one ministry gift present - that of the apostle. The ecclesia is meant to start with apostles - those who carry the Kingdom take-over mentality (Jesus set FIRST apostles - 1 Corinthians 12:28). This apostolic DNA must be imparted into the other four ministry gifts so that we carry out our work with a Kingdom mindset. People get saved with an understanding that they have a destiny to fulfil in the Kingdom - not just to escape hell! They get pastored so that they can become a part of a vital community that is changing their city. They get taught Kingdom principles, not just to be blessed, but to reform a society. This apostolically-activated body is the ecclesia that Jesus said He would build and the gates of hell would not prevail against it.

We are again in a season of reformation - Bill Hamon is calling it the Third Apostolic Reformation. We must move from being that church on the corner that simply meets people's needs, to being the Ecclesia - a people who are governmental in nature and led by that which is apostolic that will reform all seven mountains of society. It is going to take a revolution and a reformation of what we presently see as church in order to get the job done!
