The Song of Moses & The Song of the Lamb

They sing the song of Moses, the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying: "Great and marvelous are your works, Lord God Almighty! Just and true are Your ways, O King of the saints! Who shall not fear you, O Lord, and glorify Your Name? For You alone are holy. For all nations shall come and worship before You, for Your Judgements have been manifested." Revelation 15: 3 - 4


The song of Moses is a victory song that was sung on the day that God delivered the Israelites from the hand of the Egyptians. It was the day that Pharaoh's armies were all drowned in the Red Sea. The song of Moses is a declaration of God triumphing over His enemies. If that had happened in 2009, I believe that many would have found fault with Moses and the nation of Israel rejoicing over the demise of their enemies. We have been taught that when someone sins or stands against God, we should be understanding and realise that perhaps they had a bad childhood or suffered neglect. While this may be true, sin is sin and God hates it. Why do we think that we can tolerate things that God hates?

David was a man after God's heart and this is what he says in Psalm 139:19 - 22 " *Oh that you would slay the wicked O God!... for they speak against You wickedly; Your enemies take Your name in vain. Do I not hate them, O Lord who hate You? I hate them with a perfect hatred; I count them my enemies.*"

There is a place to hate the enemies of God. Jesus told us to love our enemies and pray for them, but we are to hate the sin. I believe this is what has us confused! In our efforts to love everyone, we tolerate all levels and type of sin - even in the church. But God will not be silent forever. I believe that God is wanting to come and judge the unrighteousness in our world. But in order for Him to do that, He must begin in His own house. (1 Peter 4: 17) We need to ask Him to

come and judge us so that we can repent and be holy even as He is holy. We sing the song of Moses and the song of the Lamb which celebrates the judgements of God as being just and true. As we sing, we welcome The Righteous Judge in our lives.

Many are crying out for the glory of God to come and it **will** come. Remember, the flipside of glory is judgement. His throne is founded on righteousness and justice. When He comes in glory, that same glory will judge us. In the days of Moses, the enemies drowned in water, in Revelation 15 we see that God is judging his enemies on a sea mingled with fire. The fire of God brings glory and judgement. It is a season to

call for the fire. Call for His judgements. Scripture tells us in Isaiah 26: 9 *"For when Your judgements are on the earth, the inhabitants will learn righteousness."* We are tired of seeing children raped in our nations, corruption in our government and business sector, armed robbery and indiscriminate killing. It is time for God to judge us so that His righteousness can be established in our generation.

As God was speaking to us about this, we recalled the prophetic word that James Goll gave us in 2006 when Ariel Gate was launched. God said He would teach us to have houses of fire - FIREHOUSES! (See the complete word alongside.)

We did not really understand this word until now. God wants us to be a people who raise a standard of holiness so that God can come with His fiery presence among us and begin to judge the sin around us. We need to build dwelling places for His glory - understanding that it takes holiness to stand in the fire. Isaiah 33:14, *"Who among us shall dwell with the devouring fire? Who among us shall dwell with everlasting burnings? He who walks righteously and speaks uprightly..."* The good news is that God is going to teach us how to have these houses! He is going to teach us how to build them and how to stand in the fire. So where do we start?

Ezekial 33:10-11 is our starting point. *"Son of Man, describe the temple to the house of Israel that they may be ashamed of their iniquities; and let them measure the pattern. And if they are ashamed of all they have done, make known to them the design of the temple..."* We need to go back to God's standard and begin to repent. Repent for the sin in our own lives, the sin in the life of our church. It is time to hate what God hates. We feel this so strongly that we are putting together a whole manual on repentance: How to repent, why and for what. It will include sample prayers dealing with sexual sin, soul ties, bitter root judgements, covenants with death to name a few. We aim to have it ready in time for the convention.

Intercessors - it is time to fast and repent. We want to see His judgements in the earth, understanding that it will start with us and our houses. Repentance and holiness will give us capacity to stand in the fire of His glory and begin to build a house for Him to come and dwell in. It is time for us to sing the Song of Moses and the Song of the Lamb!

Excerpt from Prophetic word given by James Goll
30 April 2006

For I will teach this ministry – Ariel Gate and the End Time Handmaidens and Servants - I will teach this ministry how to have fire houses. I will teach you how to have houses of fire, of healing presence and of worship. For there will be house groups raised up. You say, "Is this a church planting movement?" Many have said no. But the Lord says "Man's view is incomplete concerning what church actually is."

Have I not called you to bring in My government – that is My church

Have I not called you to be a reconciler in the nations – that is My church

I will teach you how to have fire houses of abandoned worship and circles of healing and that too will be My church.

So mark this day down, mark this day down. Mark this day down.

I will teach you about community. I will teach you about covenant loyalty, I will teach you that there I command the blessing. There I command the blessing of life. It is in that place of unity and covenant loyalty. There I command that Aaron's anointing flows.

I will teach you, I will teach you about apostolic lifestyle and serving and weeping and rejoicing and caring. I will teach you how to be light in dark places. I will teach you about community. Yes, many of you will be part of pockets called congregations, but you will also be a part of the community. A community that will transcend sectarianism. A community of abandoned worshippers and believing believers that will be salt and light and yet brought together. I will teach you the lost art of an apostolic lifestyle.
