

DAY 5 - 13/8/2020 - 40 DAYS OF PRAYER

There is a season to return, to come back to God. The theme of this 40 days is prepare the way of the Lord. This is the time to repent and return to the Lord.

For those who are struggling on what to eat in this fast, try a hot or cold drink of water, honey, lemon juice, ginger and cayenne. This will help the body to detoxify and you could also add turmeric to this combination.

God counts the spirits of all men at this time and we come under the rod of the Shepherd and are assessed. So imagine sheep in a field, the shepherd would let them through a narrow gate and count them as they pass under his rod. Ezekiel 20:37 NKJV *"I will make you pass under the rod, and I will bring you into the bond of the covenant."* At Rosh Hashanah God opens the books of all who have been counted, the books are assessed, everything we have thought and done are noted in our books. We can be very grateful for repentance especially when we have had thoughts and motives which are not pleasing to God. Angels cannot repent, grace is not applied to them for repentance. So fallen principalities and powers would love us to disregard repentance because if we do not repent we do not return.

We thank you for the grace given through your gift of repentance Lord. We are grateful for this gift. We are overwhelmed by your mercy Father. Thank you for using us, may you be glorified through our lives. Thank you Lord for this incredible privilege given to us to repent. Thank you for the healing the wounds of our sins through repentance. Spend some time giving God thanks for his gift of repentance. We want Gods will and Gods kingdom to come on the earth. We want what God wants!

Whatever sin I did, I wounded Jesus and I must take responsibility and identify with what I have done and feel the pain of the sin and the wounds of the sin which has been done against God. If we think about the unwarranted suffering of our Lord, repentance gives us an opportunity to soothe the heart of the Lord. Repentance is not just about us as individuals, but also about our families, communities and nations.

Thank you for being our Father, we come to you naked as we are, generation after generation we have hurt you. Thank you for the opportunity to turn back to you because of your mercies. We are exceedingly grateful, Lord, thank you Holy Spirit. Forgive us for ignoring you, not spending time with you, grant us grace, have mercy on our families and our nations, Lord, we are sorry, please forgive us.

Father we want to identify with the blood of Jesus, to take responsibility of being the cause of that pain to you, that incredible torture Jesus went through. Jessie Duplantis said the holes in Jesus' feet were so huge the light was coming through, so the holes were large holes. Thank you for the nails in your feet which allow us to walk a path. Thank for the nails in your wrists and feet, for the word says in Zechariah 13:1 *"In that day a fountain shall be opened for the house of David and for the inhabitants of Jerusalem, for sin and for uncleanness"*.

For a fountain will be opened when the Jews return and repent and they will say who put these wounds in your arms and Jesus says my people did. I agree Father, I have done things with my hands and walked in places with my feet which were against you and I am taking responsibility for the pain I have caused you. Thank you for the grace you have shown me that through your sacrifice I can be born again, and be given the opportunity to repent and be cleansed, washed by your Blood, sanctified – what an incredible gift Lord – Thank you Father.

We cannot just walk up to the throne in heaven, we must be prepared and dressed. If you really are in front of God, you will be on your face because of His immense power and glory of His presence. So there is a preparation necessary and part of teshuvah is preparing ourselves to be with the Lord. You cannot come into the throne room with bitterness in your heart, or other issues – so our lives are not about what we can hide in our lives and hearts here on earth, at the end of the day, can you stand before the Lord in righteousness and righteousness comes through preparation i.e. separated holy lifestyle, which speaks about living a sanctified life. Holiness is a discipline, it is hard, it is something I need to choose on a daily basis.

Revelation 5:10 NKJV *“And have made us kings and priests to our God; And we shall reign on the earth”* God is looking for a kingdom of priests and He is going to have a kingdom of priests from every tribe and nation. He wanted the whole nation of Israel to be priests but when the people saw the thunder, lightnings and presence of God, they were frightened and said God must rather speak to Moses. Exodus 20:18 NKJV *“When all the people witnessed the thunder and lightning, the sounding of the ram’s horn, and the mountain enveloped in smoke, they trembled and stood at a distance. “Speak to us yourself and we will listen,” they said to Moses. “But do not let God speak to us, or we will die.”*

Pentecost is about God coming down on a mountain and giving the law to his people. Jewish belief is God lifted the mountain and put it over his people like a covering and then asked His people *‘do you want to marry me’*. So God puts forth his marriage covenant in the form of ten commandments and his people hear the commandments and they must answer and affirm the marriage covenant with their God. Then Jesus buys us back from all our enemies through the incredible covenant of the Cross. So can we really understand what it means to be a priest, within the priesthood of God. What does that mean in today’s lifestyle. That is why we start repentance with *“I lay down my life...”*

Percy Collett sees the entire temple in heaven and the replica is built on earth as a practice or rehearsal of the pattern in heaven. We are practicing for the priesthood and we are doing it before all of heaven, including principalities and powers which must make them mad. As we get an understanding that we have an eternal value in God, we learn to lay our lives down and God looks at our repentance which is also recorded in our book of life. There are many books mentioned in the word of God. In the Hindu belief there are scales which would be weighed out. In Christianity, rewards are earned but it is Christ who weighs the scales of our lives. Jessie Duplantis refers to ranks of people who are recognized by their garments. God recognizes ranks according to what people have done with their lives.

Thank you Lord, for you are such a great and awesome God. Lead and guide us according to Psalm 16, that you will make me know the path of life, and at your right hand are pleasures forever more. As you clean us up, as you show us our attitudes and help us to deal with our hearts, thank you for you are such a wonderful great God and this is whom we serve. An everlasting God who has our lives written in your book and nothing is hidden from you. Thank you Lord for you are faithful and trustworthy.

Leviticus 8:33 NKJV *“You must not go outside the entrance to the Tent of Meeting for seven days, until the days of your ordination are complete; for it will take seven days to ordain you”.*

The priests have to prepare for 7 days to be sanctified for the ordination to be completed in other words, set apart for the Lord's purposes. Leviticus 8 is the inauguration of the priest. I have taught on this before (Cd teaching called *‘Standing in the door’*). For God to have a priesthood, He prepares Aaron and his sons who stand in the door for seven days. On the 8th day they are presented as the priests. God consumes what is on the altar, He also eats from the altar. Exodus 9:24 *“Fire came out from the presence of the LORD and consumed the burnt offering and the fat portions on the altar. And when all the people saw it, they shouted for joy and fell facedown.”* So every day there must be a sacrifice, to the priest and to the altar. So the altar and the priest are sharing a meal, that is why holy communion is so important. Blood and oil are put onto the altar and onto the priest. The priests cannot leave until the inauguration is done. So now Jesus comes as the lamb and high priest. Jesus has gone into the heavenlies and he has replaced the Levitical order, for when he cursed the fig tree, the other order has begun.

(Cd teaching called *‘The House of Ripe & Unripe Figs’*).

Jesus starts and finishes his ministry by overturning the tables which I taught about in my teaching, *‘Trading with Heaven’*. A theory of some person is that the feast of tabernacles is 7 days and then it has an 8 day. The person believes it will take us 7 days to put on immortality and take off mortality and then on the 8th day we will return with the Lord – for those who are prepared. So in other words we must do priestly things now so part of prayers and fasting is part of the priestly work and preparation. Laying down our lives is our main job which is represented within the pattern of the tabernacle.

The dispensation of grace will end as people curse God and refuse to repent, it is a marker of this dispensation ending. We don't know how long we have but we have less and less time because people are less and less wanting to repent or worship God. Wickedness is increasing

in the church and people are less and less seeking God. We may go as a bride but return as priests under the order of Melchizedek, so we are practicing and taking up a priestly role.

Most successful priests are the satanists and they have managed to make children the best sacrifice e.g. paedophilia, sex trafficking, abortions, Baal and Molech worship, every form of child sacrifice. We are supposed to be priests of the Most High God and we are missing in action because we want to just do church and have a great life. That is not going to win this war. We are here to lay down our lives and becoming holy priests sanctified unto you Lord.
