## **Digging Explosive Wells in Lesotho**

Its aways a pleasure going to Lesotho. We are always welcomed with such great excitement, joy and love.

All of us who attended the Lesotho conference came home with a completely new understanding of wells! Teaching out of Genesis 26, Apostle Natasha explained that during the famine, Isaac went back and re-dug his father, Abraham's, wells. The Philistines had closed them, but Isaac knew there would be water in those wells. And once he had opened them, he honoured Abraham, by restoring

the original names.

In the course of this assignment, he met with the same challenges his father had faced. Specifically, being afraid for his life, Isaac lied about his wife, Rebecca, being his sister. Just as Abraham had done before him. But Isaac worked to overcome his fear and repair his marriage. He was then able to overcome where Abraham could not and Isaac dug more wells than his father.

So what does it mean for us?

We must understand who we are married to and with whom we are in covenant. We must be connected to a well - a source of living water. Jesus is that source for us. We must be connected to Him. It is more important to hold the well, than to hold the land. If we do not have water, you will not hold anything for very long! If we are not connected to the well, Jesus, we must keep digging (repentance) and drilling (speaking in tongues) to remove every obstacle that keeps us from Him.

This was just a taste of the teaching, I could never cover all the revelation and teaching that Apostle Natasha downloaded, so I recommend you get the DVDs or Cds! All I know is that Lesotho is definitely digging wells....explosive wells!
